Markus Kummer is an Internet governance and policy expert with extensive experience in government, the United Nations, Internet institutions and non-governmental organizations. Currently, he is Chairman of the IGFSa Executive Committee. He is also a Senior Fellow of the Geneva Internet Platform and Vice-Chair of the Internet Society's Switzerland Chapter. Between 2014 and 2017 he served on the Board of the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Number (ICANN) and previously, from 2011-2014, as Vice-President of the Internet Society. From 2004-2011, he worked for the United Nations, first as Executive Coordinator of the Working Group on Internet Governance and subsequently of the Secretariat supporting the Internet Governance Forum (IGF). Markus served as a career diplomat in several functions in the Swiss Foreign Ministry between 1979 and 2004.
